

Computer Safety Tip:

Credit Card on the Internet...

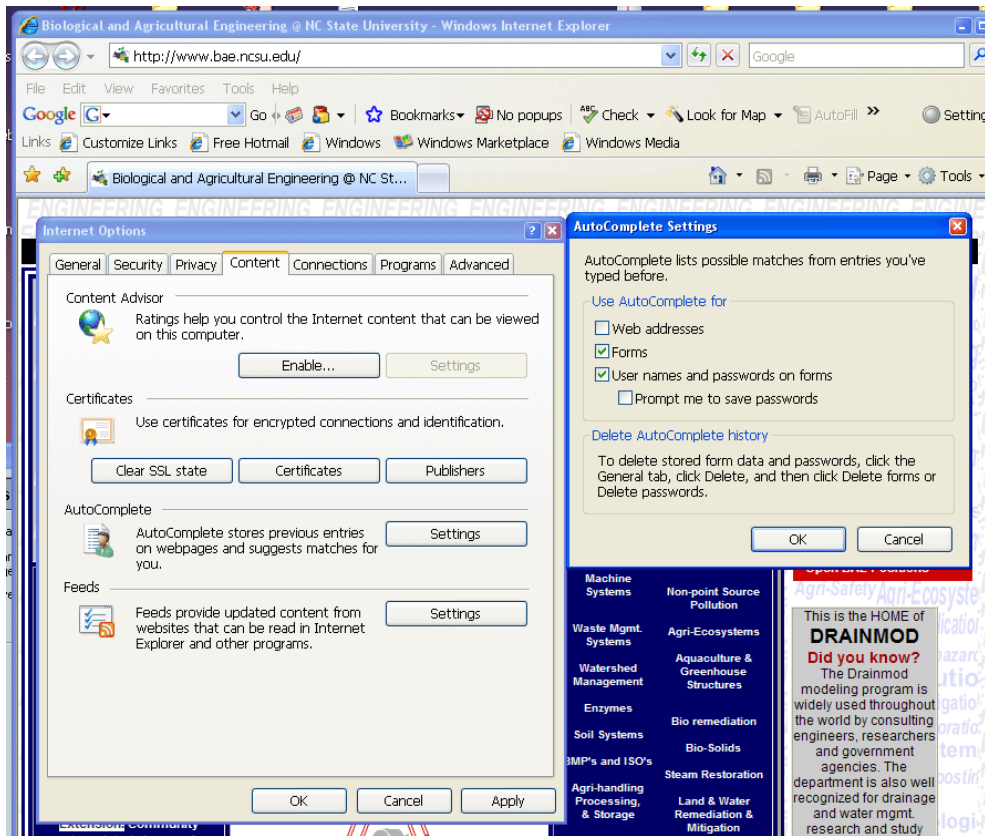


On secure sites it's fine to use a credit card but also know that the default in your Browsers Preferences is for auto forms to save and reuse information you have previously typed into an internet form. Automatically filling out forms is a nice browser feature but if you are on a public machine or shared office machine you could be giving away your information for free. If your laptop or desktop is stolen your credit card info could be gone too. And leave your machine on and then leave the room for awhile well who knows. A good policy is to clear your credit card auto form area after each purchase.

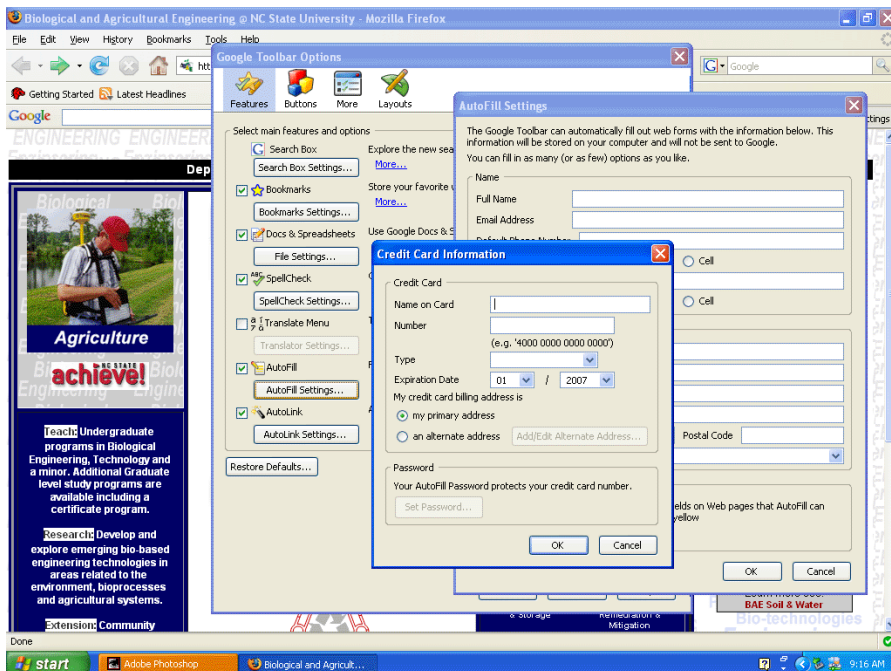

Tips: Do not use your credit card to buy items on a shared community/public machine. Always consider carefully who you allow access to your laptop or machine and to first clear the form information area (aka. computer service people).
