The restoration project under construction includes channel and floodplain grading, log and boulder vane structures, wood toe revetments, aquatic habitat enhancements, erosion control, and native riparian buffer planting. The design-build river restoration project team is a collaboration of North State Environmental and Jennings Environmental implemented with grant funding from the NC Clean Water Management Trust Fund and NC Division of Water Resources. Participants should prepare for field observation of active restoration construction and interactions with the design-build team.
